9.30 am: Installing a Lippert RV Entrance Door Friction Hinge Kit



I can honestly admit I had no idea this type of hinge ever existed until last winter when I was in Florida and my fellow R/Ver showed up in his brandy new Northern Light and showed me how he personally installed these friction hinges. (Thank you Kevin Presson)

Now some of you may have a hydraulic piston to keep your R/V door from slamming all over the

place, but that piston can weaken or even leak over time.

Once installed, you can now remove that hydraulic piston and let the friction hinges take over. These pair of friction hinges do not replace the hinges (3) that are currently mounted on your RV door.

1 friction hinge is installed between the bottom and middle hinge of your RV door.

The second friction hinge is installed between the middle and top hinge of your RV door.

So we will start this seminar/installation at the outdoor pavilion and hopefully answer any questions you may have.


Then proceed to **Site: 9** where my very good friend Myron Robinson has "Volunteered" his Lance truck camper so we can actually do a hands on installation.

Other than bringing a beverage of your choice, everything else you need is supplied.



9.30 am: Gene Thomas will be giving a seminar on brake fluid

From Gene :

'The tool I'm presenting is a device that measures the percentage of water in vehicle brake fluid. The reason this measurement is important is because most brake fluids are hydroscopic which means that they readily absorb water. Water in the hydraulic braking system is bad due to the fact it can boil under hard and/or repeated braking hot conditions and water can freeze in winter. Both of these conditions comprise the braking ability of the vehicle. It is the function of most brake fluids to dissipate water in the hydraulic braking system. Knowing the condition of your brake fluid can help determine if the brake fluid needs to be changed. '
